This Policy Statement was endorsed by the Council at its meeting on 16 January, 2000

OAVA REPRESENTATION ON WAVA COMMITTEES

BACKGROUND:

Certain aspects of WAVA administration are carried out through Committees.

Regions are entitled to appoint a Representative on each of these Committees.

Current Committees are:

- Stadia Committee
- Non-Stadia Committee
- Discipline Committee
- Doping and Medical Committee
- Law and Legislation Committee
- Records Committee
- Womens' Committee

At its meeting in January, 1998, the Assembly resolved that nominations of regional representatives to WAVA Committees be made by the Oceania Council.

POLICY STATEMENT:

OAVA Representatives to WAVA Committees will be appointed by the Oceania Council.

Appointees must be prepared to attend meetings of their Committees held at WAVA Championships and at other times and places.

Appointees must undertake to submit a formal report on each of their meetings not more than one month after the meeting date(s).

No formal process has been established for Affiliates to nominate persons for consideration by Council for nomination to any WAVA Committees. However, Affiliates may nominate individuals for consideration at any time.

The Emergency Committee of OAVA shall decide the final nominations for WAVA Committees.

The Emergency Committee may require any nominee to submit details of his/her qualifications, etc and confirm their understanding of the requirements of their nomination.

Expenses: OAVA will not reimburse expenses incurred in attending meetings held at WAVA Championships.

Where any WAVA Committee Meetings are held at other times/places, expenses incurred in attendance by OAVA Representatives must be approved in advance by the OAVA Emergency Committee, if OAVA is required to reimburse those expenses.
