POLICY STATEMENT - No. 2.3

This Policy Statement was endorsed by the Council at its meeting on 16 January, 2000

OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS:

TEAM EVENTS

BACKGROUND:

OAVA By-Laws include provision for team competition in road races, road walks, and cross-country races at Oceania Regional Championships.

The results of each age group are to be determined by totalling the times of each team's first three finishers in that age group.

There are no specified age groups for these team events.

A rigid specification of age groups can mean that in some competitions there are few teams and opportunities for athletes to be part of teams is limited.

POLICY STATEMENT:

In Oceania Championship competitions, the Organising Committee may conduct team competitions in road races, road walks, and cross-country races as provided for in OAVA By-Laws.

In order to assist competition and provide opportunities for the maximum number of athletes to be part of the team competition, the age groups for team competitions shall be decided by the Organising Committee after the closing date for entries.
